

Diller Teen Fellows Melbourne Shabbat and Kashrut Policies

Observance of Shabbat:

Diller is committed to creating a respectful and inclusive environment during all its activities, including those held over Shabbat

- Shabbat will be kept in a Halachic sense in all public places
- Where required an Eruv will be built (supervised by madirchim and checked during Shabbat)
- All programming will be Shomer Shabbat
- All food will be prepared in observance of Shabbat, supervised by the Mashgiach*

Tefilah

- An Orthodox Tefilah service will take place 3 times a day, to be supervised by a madrich/a
- Where there are more than 10 men present and the group has decided, a Torah will be brought and read at the appropriate times

Kashrut

- All catered food will be sourced by caterers or restaurants under the supervision of Kosher Australia
- All food provided during programming will be Kosher
- The Mashgiach* will be responsible for Kashering kitchens

*This will be a madrich/a who is knowledgeable in the laws of Kashrut and lives a *Shomer Mitzvot* lifestyle
