

iTaLAM is a new Hebrew digital blended learning environment based on the TaL AM program, a Hebrew language and Jewish heritage curriculum.

“Blended language learning” provides students with cutting edge digital curriculum as well as integrating the more traditional modes of learning ie: reading and writing.

iTalam provides personalized instruction and learning adapted to each student’s level and interests, an advanced Learning Management System, including advanced monitoring and reporting of students’ progress both in class and at home and an ongoing face-to-face and online teacher training.

As an add-on day to the ZFA conference, on Tuesday 14th August from 8.30AM- 3.30PM, we will provide a full day of PD for Hebrew teachers who teach iTaLAM.

We will explore how iTaLAM works spirally through each year level and look at ways to combine blended learning in our lessons. We will examine the reporting system (LMS) and its benefits in assisting teachers to write their final reports. We will learn about the online tests available in each year level and how to grade them. We will look at different writing genres and oral presentation of students and learn how to assess them.
